Fundraising Policy

Definition: Fundraising is defined as the solicitation of goods and services for sale or resale, or money for the purpose of funding or benefiting a ministry or cause.

Purpose: Since the church is a non-profit entity and abides by strict 501(c) (3) tax-exempt laws the purpose of this policy is to safeguard illegal and/or non-appropriate fundraising within the congregation.

Guidelines: Any fundraising within the congregation of Hurt Pentecostal Holiness Church (HPHC) must abide by the following guidelines:

- Only those ministries/causes that are approved by HPHC or the International Pentecostal Holiness Church (IPHC), may utilize the church resources (i.e., facilities, vehicles, supplies, directories, databases, etc.) to solicit funds. All fundraising activities must be in accordance with the mission and vision of HPHC.
- Only approved fundraising by the staff and/or a member of the church ministries cabinet (i.e., a ministry leader) shall take place.
- With the prior approval of the lead pastor and/or administrative church council missionaries, speakers and/or singing groups may use the foyer for sale of their respective ministry related items. Offerings may be received for such guests as long as they are in compliance to the 501(c) (3) guidelines.

Fundraising by any church related ministry is acceptable as long as all proceeds are used for ministry and not for personal gain. A church related ministry renting tables for events such as a bazaar is acceptable as long as there is a clear understanding that the vendors are operating separately from the church. Pastors, evangelists, speakers, singing groups that have been approved by the lead pastor or administrative church council to sell items related to their respective ministry shall be allowed as separate from the church.
