

About the Van Ministry

As part of our outreach, transportation is provided to persons who need assistance getting to and from church. Our goal is to provide transportation to church for the 11 a.m. worship service as well as our Mid-Week Ministries at 7:00 p.m. on Wednesdays. Members of this ministry also provide a valuable service, supplying transportation to and from church-wide activities and outings for other ministries. This ministry is vital in enabling many to come to worship and to find Christ.

We realize passengers of the van come from various backgrounds and some have no church experience. Our purpose is to provide a safe and positive environment for all passengers with simple rules. We believe when parents, teenagers, children, and everyone involved in the van ministry know what to expect, there's less chance for confusion and frustration. Please remember our mission is to make disciples and we encourage whole families to become involved in the local church.

The mission of the Van Ministry is to provide opportunities for evangelism and provide transportation to and from church for anyone needing transportation to church that lives within a 10-mile radius of the church. If you live further than our route

limit we would be happy to suggest another church near your location.

Passenger Rules:

1. Listen to the Leaders. While riding on the van please listen, obey, and treat with respect the van ministry leaders. No bad attitudes are allowed.
2. Personal Space. There should be no physical contact on the van. The van leaders might assign seats according to their judgment.
3. Seatbelts. No standing or squatting on the seats or in the aisles. Everyone must be seated and wearing a seatbelt.
4. Swearing, inappropriate conversation, and shouting are not tolerated on the van.
5. No cell phones, drinks, food or backpacks are to be used or consumed on to the van. Cell phones belonging to minors might be collected and returned at the conclusion of the ride home. If there is an emergency parents and/or guardians are asked to call the church or the van ministry leaders.
6. Minor Children Information Sheets must be filled out prior to being placed on the van route.
